The Bob Sauers Box Office: Opens one-hour prior to every performance in our theater lobby. Tickets are always available online at www.lafayettecivic.org

MainStage Single Ticket Prices:

- Adults (19-64) \$24 plays/\$26 musicals
- Seniors (65 & over) \$21 plays/\$23 musicals
- Active Military/Veterans (with valid id) \$21 plays/\$23 musicals
- Youth (18 & under) \$15 plays/\$17 musicals
- College Student Rush \$12 plays/\$14 musicals (with valid college id; 15 mins prior to curtain; pending availability)

Civic Youth Theatre Single Ticket Prices:

- \$14 plays/\$16 musicals (2 yrs and up/under 2 yrs must be on lap)

Patrons with Physical Limitations or Disabilities: Accommodations are available for patrons with restricted mobility, wheelchairs, or with hearing limitations. Personal hearing assistance is available upon request at the box office counter.

Late Seating Policy: Civic Theatre does not allow late seating. Performances begin promptly at scheduled times. Please be in your seat prior to curtain. Latecomers will not be allowed in the theater until intermission (when applicable). Viewing will be available via tv monitor in our lobby. **NO EXCEPTIONS.**

Lobby Bar & Concessions: Lobby Bar opens one-hour prior to curtain for every performance. Food and drink purchased at our lobby bar are allowed in the theater. No outside food or drink allowed. Please dispose of trash in our convenient lobby receptacles.

Smoking: Smoking or vaping is strictly prohibited inside the Monon Depot Theatre and within 8 feet of outside entrances.

Right to Refuse Service: Civic Staff and House Management have the right to refuse service to audience members for any reason without issuing refunds.


Electronic & Communication Devices: Absolutely no cell phone activity during performances. Photographs and recordings are strictly prohibited. Turn off all sound making devices prior to curtain. Violators of this policy will be asked to leave and will not be refunded.

Parking: Civic Theatre offers complimentary parking behind our theater. Handicapped parking is clearly marked, and violators will be towed at the owner's expense. Additional parking is available off-street. Civic Theatre is not responsible for any lost or stolen property from vehicles while parked on our premises.

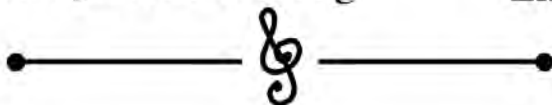

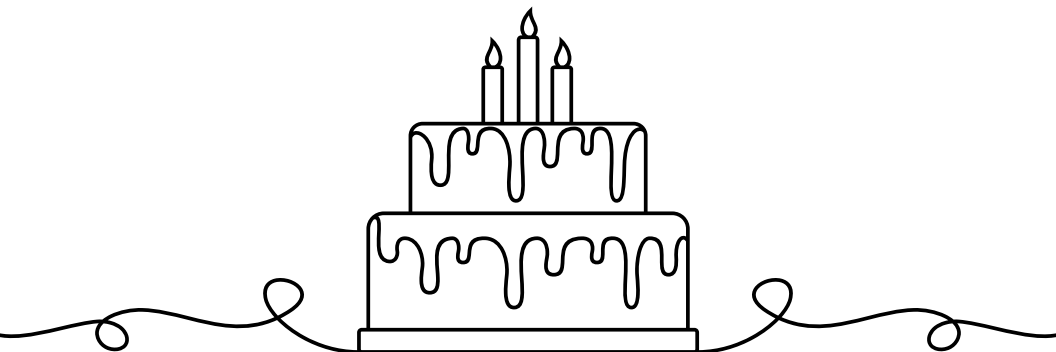
A NOTE FROM THE DIRECTOR

Full disclosure here: I hate writing Director's Notes. I never really know what to write about any play and production I direct. More importantly, the actors and designers are the ones who give the story to the audience. It's always a collaboration among us, a process I treasure and highly respect. Audiences receive the story through how the designers have created the world of the play in the set, costumes, lights and sound, and how the actors inhabit and express their characters.

There is a truism in theatre: we really don't know what the play is, until the audience engages and responds and lets us know. So you, our audience, are the final piece of the puzzle, the final character in the play. You will let us know what we have created. The great playwright, director and theatre critic, George Bernard Shaw, said this of directors: The Director is the Ideal Audience of One. So, my job is to engage in design discussions and rehearsals as that "Audience of One", and make sure the company is telling the story to the best of our abilities and talents.

And, finally, we invite you to tell us what that story is, what it means. So, with all my gratitude and trust, thank you.

Who's Who in the CAST!



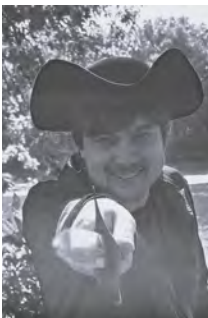

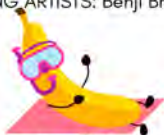

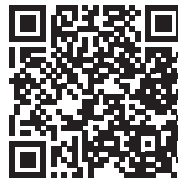
