

The Bob Sauers Box Office: Opens one-hour prior to every performance in our theater lobby. Tickets are always available online at www.lafayettecivic.org

MainStage Single Ticket Prices:

- Adults (19-64) \$24 plays/\$26 musicals
- Seniors (65 & over) \$21 plays/\$23 musicals
- Active Military/Veterans (with valid id) \$21 plays/\$23 musicals
- Youth (18 & under) \$15 plays/\$17 musicals
- College Student Rush \$12 plays/\$14 musicals (with valid college id; 15 mins prior to curtain; pending availability)

Civic Youth Theatre Single Ticket Prices:

- \$14 plays/\$16 musicals (2 yrs and up/under 2 yrs must be on lap)

Patrons with Physical Limitations or Disabilities: Accommodations are available for patrons with restricted mobility, wheelchairs, or with hearing limitations. Personal hearing assistance is available upon request at the box office counter.

Late Seating Policy: Civic Theatre does not allow late seating. Performances begin promptly at scheduled times. Please be in your seat prior to curtain. Latecomers will not be allowed in the theater until intermission (when applicable). Viewing will be available via tv monitor in our lobby. NO EXCEPTIONS.

Lobby Bar & Concessions: Lobby Bar opens one-hour prior to curtain for every performance. Food and drink purchased at our lobby bar are allowed in the theater. No outside food or drink allowed. Please dispose of trash in our convenient lobby receptacles.

Smoking: Smoking or vaping is strictly prohibited inside the Monon Depot Theatre and within 8 feet of outside entrances.

Right to Refuse Service: Civic Staff and House Management have the right to refuse service to audience members for any reason without issuing refunds.

Electronic & Communication Devices: Absolutely no cell phone activity during performances. Photographs and recordings are strictly prohibited. Turn off all sound making devices prior to curtain. Violators of this policy will be asked to leave and will not be refunded.

Parking: Civic Theatre offers complimentary parking behind our theater. Handicapped parking is clearly marked, and violators will be towed at the owner's expense. Additional parking is available off-street. Civic Theatre is not responsible for any lost or stolen property from vehicles while parked on our premises.

Tribute to John Christopher Jones and Civic Theatre of Greater Lafayette

Jim and Pat Ross remember when ALCOA agreed to underwrite a three-year program that would bring a number of rising young performing artists to the Lafayette area for six weeks a year.

The second performer to arrive in Lafayette, Indiana, was a young actor named John Christopher Jones, and the sponsor was Civic Theatre. Chris delighted many audiences with his theatrical ability. After his time in Lafayette, Chris returned to New York City and continued to build a career acting and directing on Broadway, off-Broadway, in video, and film. Christopher was a regular on "On Our Own" and "The Popcorn Kid." Movies include Moonstruck, Awakenings, and Desperate Hours. Christopher later developed Parkinson's disease, which has not kept him from performing and directing.

In what may be his greatest one-time performance, Chris and Dan Moran, both suffering from Parkinson's, star in the documentary "Me to Play." It is a performance of Beckett's End Game while also showing the daily challenge of dealing with Parkinson's Disease.

A NOTE FROM THE DIRECTOR

As we present *Psycho Beach Party* in a world where identity is under constant scrutiny, it's impossible to ignore the oppressive new gender laws sweeping through places like Indiana. These laws, which threaten to erase the fluidity of gender and restrict basic rights, serve as a stark reminder of the importance of representation—not just in the theater, but in every aspect of our lives.

Psycho Beach Party is a show that revels in its chaos, its humor, and its unapologetic exploration of gender and identity. It's a piece of theater that invites us to laugh at the absurdities of life while also forcing us to confront the realities of who we are and who we are allowed to be. In the face of laws that seek to stifle the voices of trans, non-binary, and gender non-conforming people, we need stories like this more than ever—stories that embrace diversity in all its forms, and that celebrate the full spectrum of human experience.

The characters in *Psycho Beach Party* might be exaggerated or cartoonish, but they are also deeply human. They are people who are grappling with their identities, pushing back against the boxes society tries to force them into, and finding themselves in the process. Whether it's Chicklet's journey to self-acceptance or the campy overtones of the show, this piece embodies a spirit of freedom—freedom that feels increasingly threatened in today's political climate.

Representation matters because it allows people to see themselves. It allows them to feel validated, seen, and heard. But beyond visibility, it's about agency—about empowering those whose identities are often silenced or erased. In a time when laws are being passed to restrict access to healthcare, education, and basic freedoms for trans people, and when queer identities are being weaponized for political gain, it's crucial that we tell stories that offer a counter-narrative. We must remind ourselves, and the world, that everyone deserves the right to exist authentically, unapologetically, and joyfully.

As we step into this world of 1960s beach culture, B-movie tropes, and psychological thrills, I ask you to consider the power of the stories we choose to tell and the lives we choose to honor with our representation. *Psycho Beach Party* is not just a campy romp—it's a bold stand against erasure. It's an act of defiance, of joy, and of solidarity with all those who are fighting for their right to be seen as they truly are.




